PSPCL to ensure that the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement are completed and complied with within one month failing which PSPCL may proceed further to take action as per law.

PSPCL to ensure that the electric supply to any consumer in the franchisee area is not disconnected except due to non-payment of energy bill as per Regulation 32 of the Supply Code, 2014.

The petition shall be taken up for hearing / arguments on 25.04.2018 at 11.00 A.M.
