In the matter of: Petition under Section 45 and Section 46 of Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Intra-State Open Access) Regulations, 2011 for directing the transmission licensee to exempt penalty on the power drawn above the admissible drawal and up to contract demand under Force Majeure condition and removal of other difficulties in open access and petition under Section 142 of Electricity Act, 2003 for taking necessary action against the respondent and its officials for issuing commercial circular No.29/2015 followed by commercial circular No.8/2015 dated 02.03.2015 contrary to the amendment dated 01.06.2015 carried out by this Commission in Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for intra-State Open Access) (5th Amendment) Regulations, 2015 and in violation of the provisions of Electricity Act, 2003, provisions of Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for intrastate Open Access) Regulations, 2011 and General Conditions of Tariff and Schedule of Tariff

The learned counsel for the Respondent No.1 i.e. PSPCL has contended that the orders in Petition No.47 of 2015 cover only bilateral transactions and therefore, the letter issued by the Commission to the Chief Engineer/SLDC, PSTCL / Tariff / P-47-2015/818 dated 22.04.2016 should also cover only bilateral transactions & not collective transactions. Before proceeding further in the petition the learned counsel requested that the Commission may take a view in this regard.

The matter is adjourned and the petition is fixed for further hearing on 10.08.2017 at 11.30 A.M.
