ORDER

The petition came up for hearing. The learned Counsel of PSPCL supplied the comments on the validation report for all 132/220 kV Substations conducted by PSTCL. However, the Circle-wise abstract of excess pumped energy claimed by PSPCL on all 132/220 kV Substations against the validation conducted by PSTCL is

not supplied. PSPCL is directed to supply the abstract of the same along with names of the officers responsible for claiming excess pumped energy and action taken against the delinquent/erring officers/officials. PSPCL assured to supply the same and prayed for taking a lenient view in view of the lot of improvement made by PSPCL after the detailed guidelines on the subject were issued by the Commission. The learned Counsel of PSPCL also submitted that the number of the feeders to which the averages are added have reduced considerably and the number of the feeders to which the averages were added got reduced to the range of 0.39% to 1.65% after implementation of the guidelines issued by the Commission. The quantum of averages to the pumped energy has also reduced after the issue of the guidelines by the Commission.

PSTCL, vide Memo No.122 dated 04.01.2017, submitted the counter comments on the rejoinder of PSPCL regarding excess pumped energy claimed for 220 kV Substation, Ajitwal. The Commission observed that the letter dated 27.12.2016 of Chief Engineer/P&M, PSTCL, Ludhiana, referred repeatedly in the said reference, was not enclosed for proper interpretation of the comments of PSTCL. Accordingly, PSTCL is directed to supply the same at the earliest.

PSPCL is directed to supply the number & date of charge sheets/show cause notices issued to the delinquent officers/officials for booking excess Pumped Energy to AP feeders within 15 days from the date of issue of this Order..
